**New hours will be starting May 10<sup>th</sup> 2020.** We are in the process of ordering magnets to hand out but in the meantime we have a small flyer you can pick up.

\* Tuesdays from 6:30-9:00am are reserved for seniors and those at high risk. Anyone can come if needed, but please be respectful.

Yard waste and leaves have been moved to behind the fenced refrigerator disposal area. You will see an area marked with red paint. Remember no plastics of any kind or wood in with these materials.

We have several requests for our protection and yours:

- Please sort all of your recyclables at home and be mindful of the acceptable items for each area. This will also help keep us safe from handling these items.
- We have safe areas marked off with traffic cones, please respect these areas.
- Remember all trash must be in closed bags and please push your trash bags down off the table.
- Practice social distancing and try not socialize as we would like to avoid congested areas.

All five towns share in the cost incurred by the Construction/Demolition (landfill) containers, therefore it is only fair that fees apply to everyone who has a use for them. This cost has been long-standing, and going forward we appreciate your cooperation and respect for a job we are trying to do for the benefit of all.

- Fees apply to items deposited into the Construction/Demolition containers, except kitty litter. Please see attendant. Presently food waste needs to be in the trash (incinerator).
- If at all possible pay by check on fee-based items so the handling of money is kept to a minimum. Please have your phone number and correct address on the check.

We now have a means of recycling vegetable and nut oils. NOT accepted are solid shortening or bacon grease. Please see attendant for more information.

Household Hazardous Waste Day is scheduled for **Saturday June 27<sup>th</sup>**. More details will be on the town calendar. You must have a facility sticker to participate. We will be tracking who comes that day so I suggest to keep the process flowing bring an address label that you can put on our tally sheet instead of writing your name and address.

A new sticker program will hopefully be coming later this year, so for now the present stickers are acceptable. We are also asking for volunteers to help with the process and I am suggesting a volunteer from each town. Contact anyone at the recycling center with your information if interested.

We are doing all we can to make your visit in this trying time to be as quickly as possible and go smoothly.
