



WILTON HEALTH OFFICER ANNOUNCEMENT

The Wilton Select Board, in conjunction with the Town Clerk/Tax Collector, is pleased to announce that the Town Hall will begin a phased reopening starting June 1, 2021.

Starting June 1st the Town Clerk/Tax Collector's office and the Land Use/Building Department will reopen only by appointment during regular business hours Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. The Select Board Office has been open throughout the pandemic with COVID-19 protocols in place.

Customers who cannot conduct their business by drop-box, phone, internet or email will have to schedule an appointment.

Town Clerk/Tax Collector appointments will be available for new vehicle registrations, vehicle plate transfers, marriage licenses, voter registration, and notarial services. All other transactions will continue to be done by mail, drop-box, phone, email, and online. Additional in-person transactions will be added at a later date.

It is very important to schedule your appointment and be on time; customers who are late will not be admitted to the building.

MASKS ARE REQUIRED for entrance to Town Hall.

Accommodations will be made to complete all business outside for customers who cannot or will not wear a mask.

For the safety of our staff and other customers it is important that our customers be mindful of their health and do NOT come to Town Hall if you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms.
